**CORONA LIGHT TO SPONSOR "HALL OF FAME CLASSIC"
TABLE SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIPS IN LAS VEGAS**

**"Foosball" Players from Around the World Compete for \$90,000
in Combined Tournament and League Prizes**

Las Vegas, NV – Hundreds of the top table soccer players in the world are already beginning to converge on Las Vegas, Nevada to compete in a unique sports event: the Valley-Tornado Hall of Fame Classic and International League Championships. Taking place March 26-30, 2008 at the Riviera Hotel, the tournament will also feature announcement of this year's inductees into the Foosball Hall of Fame and the annual Valley International Foosball League Championships.

At this year's event, all eyes will be on members of the U.S. National Table Soccer Team and Team USA as they face many top international rivals for the first time since the fiercely competitive 2007 season. Premier players such as world #1-ranked Frederico Collignon of Belgium, #2-ranked Rob Atha of the UK and many others will be in attendance, giving American "foosers" an ideal opportunity to gauge their table skills against some of their most likely competition throughout the 2008 World Tour.

As an International Table Soccer Federation (ITSF) sanctioned tournament, the top finisher in Open Singles automatically wins an expense-paid trip to the ITSF World Championships Finals in Italy in October, while all participants in Open Singles, Open Doubles and Women's Singles also earn rankings points towards additional trips to Italy. In addition to tournament competition, the Las Vegas event will also feature the culmination of a year of table soccer league competition with a special league playoff and awards banquet.

The tournament is sponsored by Corona Light, and sanctioned by both the ITSF and the United States Table Soccer Federation (USTSF). All competition will take place on Tornado Table Soccer™ tables, made by the Valley-Dynamo division of Brunswick, Inc. With categories for men and women and beginner through Master, the annual event is open to all comers. Numerous specialty categories are also included such as 18 & Under Doubles, 50 & Over Doubles, Forward Shootout, and Goalie Wars, with most finals held on Sunday the 30th. There are entry fees for players who wish to compete in an event, but there is no admission fee to enter the tournament room – both press and spectators are very welcome to visit.

Other ITSF 2008 World Tour events in the United States are scheduled to take place in Kentucky, North Carolina, Colorado, Louisiana and Texas, while table soccer players from over 50 countries are gearing up for further ITSF competition in Austria, Canada, Czech Republic, France, Germany, Japan, Mexico, Poland, South Africa, the UAE and the UK, among others. In fact, this year's 55-tournament, five-continent tour will be the largest worldwide table soccer pro tour ever!
